H&F offer free and low cost activities at family hubs, children's centres and during holiday periods. Includes activities for you and your baby and for children and young people including those with SEND.

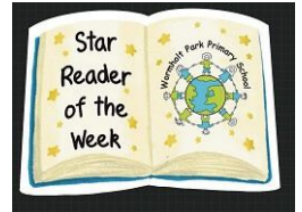

This week, the Star Readers of the Week are Aliya from Ottawa Class (Reception) and Sabrin from Tripoli Class (Y5). Well Done!

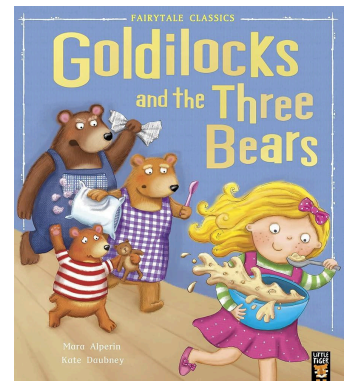


Class Book Review
