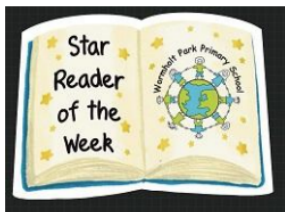

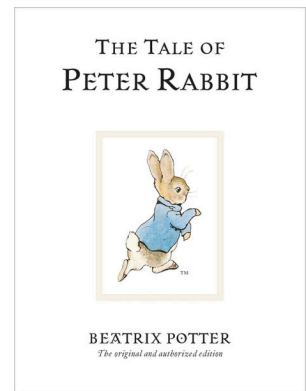
There was lots of laughter as we followed his mischievous behaviour and breathed a sigh of relief each time he managed to escape!
