Geography



This half term, we have a Geography focus. We will be learning about the Alps. Children will research and learn to locate the Alps on a world map and identify and label the eight countries they spread through. They will also research and describe the physical and human features of Innsbruck. Children will compare the human and physical differences, using a variety of data collection methods including completing a questionnaire, mapping their route and recording their findings in sketches or photographs.

English:



We will be studying Playscripts and Recounts.

Children will be using our Core reading text to write these genres.

Children will develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions where they will be answering vocabulary, inference, prediction, explain, retrieval and summarise style questions linked to the chosen text.

We will be covering the following topics this half term:

- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions
- Decimals and percentages

Every <u>Tuesday</u>, children will have an arithmetic focus for maths.

Science:





This half term, we will be learning about the Earth, Sun & Moon including:

- Understanding that the movement of the Earth and other planets is relative to the Sun
- Being able to describe the movement of the moon and how it is relative to the Earth.

Digital Literacy: *Programming*Pupils will be learning how to use scratch,

appropriately to programme music.

Art/DT: We will be focussing on developing prototypes using electrical components.

Music: We will be learning the key features of Blues music

French: French adjectives of colour, shape and size.
