H&F offer free and low cost activities at family hubs, children's centres and during holiday periods. Includes activities for you and your baby and for children and young people including those with SEND.



This week, the Star Readers of the week are Almir from Havana Class (Y1) and Shad from Washington Class (Y). Well Done!




Class Book Review

All children with a date of birth between **1 September 2021 - 31 August 2022** need to apply.

Please note: There is no automatic transfer from nursery to reception. Applications must be made through your Local Authority.
