## Help to wrap presents

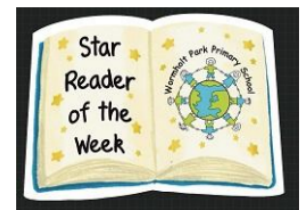
Do you have some time to spare next week?

This week, the Star Readers of the week are Ayaan from Lima Class (Y2) and Dina A from Athens Class (Y4). Well Done!

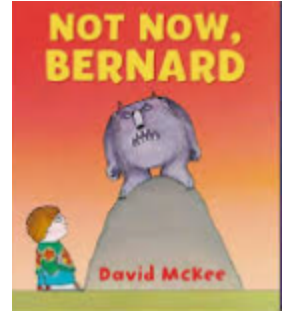


## Class Book Review
