### Humanities: Geography



This term our humanities focus is *Geography*. We will be finding answers to the question 'Why is our world wonderful?' Children will:

- identify human and physical features
- name and locate the 5 oceans on a world map
- use an aerial photo to draw a simple sketch map

### English:



We will be writing narratives inspired by Traditional Tales. We will be sharing the story *The Jolly Postman* by Allan & Janet Ahlberg.

Children will develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions when they will be answering retrieval, inference and word meaning questions.

### Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this half term:

- Multiplication and division
- length and height
- mass, capacity and temperature

### Science:



Our science topic this half term is: *Animals: Life Cycles and Health*

Children will:

- learn that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- understand why humans exercise, eat different types of food, and keep clean.

## Times Tables:




