Geography: Investigating



This half term we have a geography focus and will be learning about where our food comes from. Children will be:

- Identify the different biomes of the world and what food grows in each
- Explore and Compare the benefits of responsible trading and food imports
- Collect data and use a scale bar appropriately

English:



We will be working on writing a Newspaper article and a character description.

The children will be writing from the perspective of the character Arthur from our core reading text.

Children will continue to develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions where they be looking at inference skills and summarising main ideas.

Our grammar for this half term will be formal and commanding language and time adverbials.

Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this term:

- Timetables up to 12x12
- Fraction of objects and amounts
- Area
- Money
- Properties of Shape

Science:



This half term we will have a physics focus for Science and will be looking at Changing Sounds.

Children will learn about the structure of the human ear and how sound travels. They will also learn about pitch and vibrations created by musical instruments.

They will also investigate the natural world to discover how different mammals hear.

- Dash robots

Art/DT: We will be looking at mechanical systems and making slingshot cards

Music: We will be continuing with guitar this half term.

RHE: We will be learning about Human Rights and Diversity in Citizenship

French: We will be learning about the weather and the water cycle

PE is on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons. Children should bring their PE kits into school to get changed. This half term, we will be learning dance and netball.

Spellings:



Our spelling focus this half term is:

- 's'sound spelt with sc, ce and ci
- Word Families

Children should learn their spellings each week using: Look, Say Cover, Write Check.

Children will have a spelling test every Wednesday.

Reading:

Children should read for at least 15 minutes every day.

Times Tables:

Children should practice their timetables every day.

They will have a timetables test every Friday.

They have their Multiplication Table Check (MTC) in the Summer term.
