All sessions are free, but places are limited.

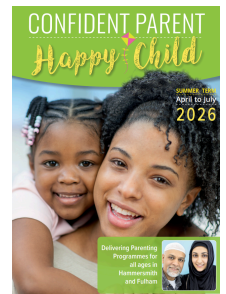

Henry is a FREE 8 week course for children aged 0 – 5 years that supports healthy routines, wellbeing and parenting confidence. Research shows that the key ingredients to ensuring babies and young children have a healthy start in life are: • Parenting confidence • Physical activity for little ones • What children and families eat • Family lifestyles habits • Enjoying life together This programme covers these 5 themes across the 8 weeks and provides everything you need to help get your child off to a great start!
