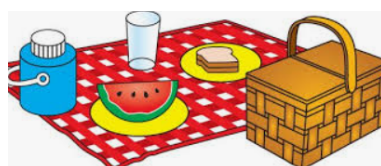

Class Book Review

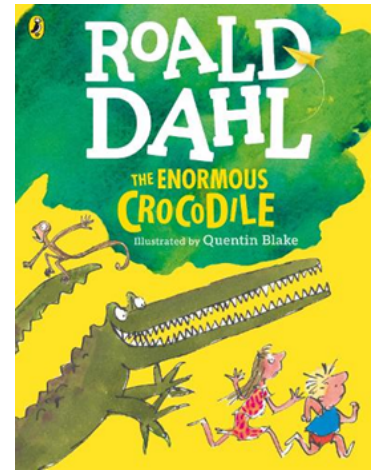
This week, we have a book review from Lima Class (Year 2)


