Enjoy reading the newsletter and have a lovely weekend everyone 😊

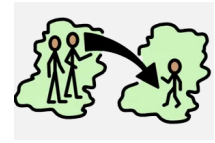

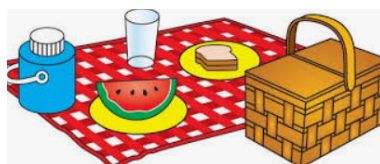

# Navigating Mealtimes with sensory challenges

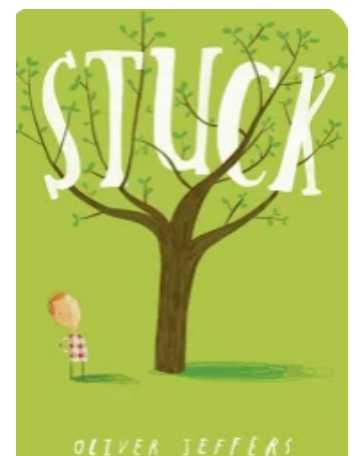
## Class Book Review



# Opal Playground

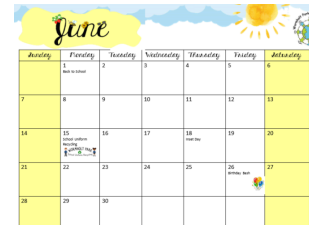
Just a reminder for all children to bring a coat every day and have a spare change of clothes at school in case they get wet/muddy.
