### Humanities: Geography



This half term we are continuing our geography focus. We will be learning about Rivers. Children will be:

- Locating the rivers in the UK
- Locating rivers in the World
- Learning how rivers are used

### English:

Children will continue to develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions where they be looking at prediction skills and summarising main ideas.

Our grammar focus for this half term will be inverted commas (speech marks). We will also be consolidating all previous learning.

- Statistics
- Geometry
- Timetables

Children will take their Multiplication Timetables Check (MTC) in the first two weeks back.

### Science:



This half term we will be making connections: How does the flow of liquids compare?

- Apply knowledge in new contexts.
- Carry out a full scientific enquiry.

- Children will be looking how to stay safe online.

- Pupil will be learning to investigate the weather

**Art/DT:** We will be looking at Electrical Systems

**Music:** We will be continuing with guitar this half term.

**RE:** We will be looking at symbols across religions

**French:** We will be learning about music
